



This memorandum of understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is made on this 29th day of the Month of **December** of the year **2023** by and between **iiiEM**, an autonomous body registered under Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Director General of Foreign Trade & Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises) having its head office at Office -201-202, Iscon Avenue, Opp Choice restaurant, C.G.Road Ahmedabad, Gujarat, India [hereinafter called "iiiEM"/ First Party], on the ONE PART

And

N.S.Patel Arts (Autonomous) College, Anand, Affiliated to Sardar Patel University, Vallabh Vidyanagar Managed by Sardar Patel Education Trust, Anand [hereinafter called "NSPAC"/Second Party] on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MOU are hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties).

The parties, having a discussion on collaborative dealing with the aspects of training, extension activities and research have decided to enter long-term collaboration in training, development, and skills enhancement (such as persuasive, value communication, data-driven critical thinking, and business analytics in global market, foreign trade, and international business of the stakeholders) of the students of NSPAC.

1. Purpose:

1.1 The primary purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaborative framework between NSPAC and iiiEM for the training and skill enhancement of the college students. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

1.2 The secondary purpose of this MoU are as mentioned:

- a) Collaborative organization of training and extension activities to make people aware about the exploration of opportunities in export and import sector.
- b) Create opportunity for student and scholars also to exchange research ideas with each other.
- c) Cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings
- d) Workout and establish an "Export Business Start-Up Helpdesk" at NSPAC, for the aspirants interested in Export Business.

2. Duration:

2.1 The MoU shall be effective from 1st January 2024 to 31st December 2026, unless terminated by either party with prior written notice.

3. Training Programs:

3.1 iiiEM will provide training programs and workshops to enhance the skills of the college students in the field of export-import and shipping & logistics.

3.2 The programs will be conducted on the premises of NSPAC.

4. Industrial visits and port visits

4.1 The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. iiiEM will impart hands-on training to the students enrolled with the NSPAC based on availability of such facilities with it. Such visits might bear nominal charges which will be decided and collected separately at the time of such visit. The charges should be enough to cover the expenses of such trip.

5. Fee Structure:

5.1 NSPAC is authorized to collect fees directly from the students participating in the training programs.

5.2 The fee structure will be as per the terms outlined in the Annexure B attached herewith.

5.3 It is understood by iiiEM that NSPAC is exempted from Goods and Service Tax and it won't levy any tax on the fees as mentioned in the annexure

5.4 The fees of the program is to be completely collected and the share of iiiEM has to be transferred before the start of the program

6. Revenue Sharing:

6.1 A revenue-sharing mechanism will be established, as detailed in the Annexure B, outlining the percentage distribution of fees between NSPAC and iiiEM.

6.2 The revenue-sharing arrangement may be subject to periodic review and adjustments as mutually agreed upon.

7. Roles & Responsibilities:

As mentioned in the Annexure A

8. Monitoring and Evaluation:

8.1 Both parties agree to establish a mechanism for monitoring the progress of the training programs.



8.2 Regular evaluations and feedback sessions will be conducted to ensure the effectiveness of the training.

9. Confidentiality:

9.1 Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary information shared during the collaboration.

9.2 Any data related to students and training outcomes shall be treated with utmost confidentiality.

9.3 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with laws of India. In the event of any dispute, the parties shall endeavour to resolve the dispute by amicable discussions within 30 days of either party calling for amicable settlement of disputes.
