



6.4.3 - Institutional strategies for mobilization of funds

Our college gets funds through different resources. The **main sources** of the college funds are:

- 1.Grants from the state government
- 2.Grants under different UGC schemes
- 3.Grants from MHRD, New Delhi
- 4.Grants from ICHR (New Delhi), ICSSR (New Delhi), CIIL (Mysore), Sahitya Akademi (New Delhi), Gujarat Sahitya Akademi (Gandhinagar), Meghani Lok Sahitya Kendra (Rajkot), and other funding agencies.
- 5.Grants from Sardar Patel Education Trust
- 6.Fees by the students of self-financed courses

Optimal utilization of resources:

Seminars and Workshops: The college obtains grants for organizing seminars, workshops, and conferences from different agencies like ICHR, ICSSR, CIIL, Sahitya Akademy, Gujarat Sahitya Akademy, Meghani Lok Sahitya Kendra, etc. The college has organized many national and international level conferences, seminars, and workshops from these grants.

Infrastructure: The college has applied the development grants in creating and upgrading the services like ICT facilities, Library, Research, and Publication Cell, Rifle Shooting Range, Gym (Fitness Centre), Recording and Photography Studios, Kitchen, etc.

ICT Facilities: Classroom Projectors having lower configuration are upgraded to higher configuration. The college has received a grant under RUSA 2.0. Under this, the college aspires to upgrade its IT infrastructure by purchasing computers, video conferencing systems, sound systems for the smart classroom, LED projectors and printers.

Library: The grants for strengthening academic resources have been used efficiently for upgrading library resources and facilities. Today, the college has enormous books on different subjects and has total 74 subscribed journals and magazines. The college has turned its library into the fully automated library with the facility of RFID.

Research and Publication Cell: A well-equipped Research and Publication Cell has been developed from the grants received from different sources.

Rifle Shooting Range: The college has set up a rifle shooting range with all the modern state-of-the-art facilities to promote an interest in sports.

Recording Studio: The college has recently set-up a recording studio for recording the lectures of the teachers and video conferencing from the grants received from different sources.

Photography Studio: The college has established a photography studio for providing practical exposure to the students of a course on photography from the grants received from different sources.
