

## **ABOUT LUCKNOW**



The name of Lucknow city can be traced back to the epic "Ramayan". When Lord Rama returned to Ayodhya, after 14 years of exile he gifted this place to his younger brother Lakshman. Who is believed to have stayed in Lakshman Teela, a high ground on the banks of the Gomti. Later, the region was named after his as 'Lakshmanpur'. There are other stories that do the rounds Lucknow was named after a very influential person called 'Lakhan Ahir' who built the fort 'Qila Lakhan'. The name 'Qila Lakhan' later became Lucknow. Some other sources says that one Lakhu Khan, earlier a non - Muslim having the name Laxan Singh, had lent his name to Lucknow.

The city has archaeological remains dating back to 3000 BC but Lucknow's foundations were laid in the 13th century A. D. Lakshman Teela, the central part of the city, is believed to have been the site where a fort was built by a calm from Bijnor. By the end of the 13th century, the fort had fallen into the hands of the Sharqui rulers of Janunpur. Who held it till 1476 in the 1540s, the fort was annexed by the Sultan of Delhi, Sher Shah Suri (Regained 1540 - 45). Historically, Cantonments were places where the army of colonial government had to be exclusively quartered in an effort to keep the armed forces totally insulated from the ruled.





# 5. REPORT OF THE AGENCY VISITS

## DAY-1

Date: 04<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2023 Day: Wednesday

## Visit of Legislative Assembly of Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh)



The State of Uttar Pradesh has a bicameral legislature comprising of Legislative Council, an upper House and Legislative Assembly, the lower House. This is the largest legislature in India. The Uttar Pradesh Assembly consists of 403 elected Member. The Uttar Pradesh Legislative Council has 100 members. Prior to 1967, the strength of the Legislative Assembly

was 431 members including one nominated Anglo-Indian member which was revised to 426 including one nominated Anglo-Indian member. The study tour began with the visit of legislative Assembly of Uttar Pradesh.

#### **Interaction of Students**

The students of social work had visited legislative assembly of Uttar Pradesh, where they were address by Marshal Capt. Manish Rai. He oriented them about functions of assembly and working procedure of legislative assembly. The students also visited different area of assembly like assembly hall, photo gallery, library & museum. Mr. Rai also gave information that the structure of assembly



building was one of heritage building of Lucknow which has completed 101 years. The social

work students asked him many questions about Legislative Assembly of U.P like kind of what is legislative assembly, structure, how to work in legislative assembly, the difference between legislative assembly and legislative council, how many members of legislative assembly and how elected and selected. The Woman Marshal explain about there are total 403 member in which 402 elected and 1 nominated member of legislative assembly. Then explained about legislative assembly and legislative council. The students also visited different area of assembly like library & museum. The assembly library all language book available like English, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit etc. The total 15 lake book available in legislative assembly.



Then we were taken a holocaust ride in Uttar Pradesh. Where we visited all the places of Uttar Pradesh through a project like Kumbh mela, Akbar Killa, Lahad, Banaras, Pavitra Ganga arti, Kashi Vishwanath temple, Gorakhpur temple, Ayodhya, hanuman garhi, Lucknow, Rumi Darwaja, Imambara, Ambedkar memorial park, Legislative assembly, Cricket

stadium etc. The history of the assembly was shown through digital video. After that Legislative Assembly visit was absolutely nice.

## **Visit Ummeed NGO**



UMMEED NGO is a Guinness World Record Holder and Limca Book Record Holder formed in 20 to fill vacuum in the area of Homeless and Migrants in the state of Uttar Pradesh. The second visit of the day was Ummeed Foundation which work for mentally retarded women. Mr. Pratap Vikram Singh guided students about their work. At there they met members of organization and got details about

working procedure of organization and services provided by organization to women. They also got information about problems faced by organization during their work.

The Ummeed foundation NGO established in 2004 under Society Registration Act 1860. The NGO was working about Woman Empowerment Mentality. After that rehabilitation shelter home available of Ummeed NGO, the 12 shelter in U.P. 9 shelter home in lucknow and I hamidpur in near ummeed NGO. Then Mr. Pratap Vikram said 80 woman. in ummeed foundation and in this NGO.



500 people rehabilited. There are only female staff work in NGO. Then social work students visited of ummeed shelter home.






1,85,800 sq. m. The mall was opened on 11 July 2022, by then Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, Shri Yogi Adityanath.


